1. GOD TAKES CARE OF HIS PEOPLE

² The Jews assembled in their cities throughout all the provinces of King Ahasuerus to lay hands on those who sought their harm; and no one could stand before them, for the dread of them had fallen on all the peoples.

Esther 9:2

- **THROUGH NORMAL CIRCUMSTANCES OF LIFE**
- **THROUGH NORMAL PEOPLE LIKE US**

³ Even all the princes of the provinces, the satraps, the governors, and those who were doing the king's business assisted the Jews, because the dread of Mordecai had fallen on them. ⁴ Indeed, Mordecai was great in the king's house, and his fame spread throughout all the provinces; for the man Mordecai became greater and greater. Esther 9:3-4

2. JUDGMENT COMES ON EVIL DOERS

*⁶ And in Susa the capital the Jews killed and destroyed **five hundred** men, Esther 9:6*

*¹⁰ the **ten sons** of Haman Esther 9:10*

*¹⁵ And the Jews who were in Susa assembled also on the fourteenth day of the month Adar and killed **three hundred** men in Susa, Esther 9:15*

*¹⁶ Now the rest of the Jews who were in the king's provinces assembled, to defend their lives and rid themselves of their enemies, and kill **75,000** of those who hated them; Esther 9:16*

¹¹ Then I saw a great white throne and Him who sat upon it, from whose presence earth and heaven fled away, and no place was found for them. ¹² And I saw the dead, the great and the small, standing before the throne, and books were opened; and another book was opened, which is the book of life; and the dead were judged from the things which were written in the books, according to their deeds. Revelation 20:11-12

3. GOD EXALTS THOSE WHO HONOR HIM

- **THEY GIVE UNCONDITIONALLY**

⁷ He was bringing up Hadassah, that is Esther, his uncle's daughter, for she had no father or mother. Now the young lady was beautiful of form and face, and when her father and her mother died, Mordecai took her as his own daughter....⁸ Esther was taken to the king's palace into the custody of Hegai, who was in charge of the women. Esther 2:7-8

- **THEY SERVE DUTIFULLY**

*² And all the accomplishments of his authority and strength, and the full account of the greatness of Mordecai, to which **the king advanced him**, are they not written in the Book of the Chronicles of the Kings of Media and Persia? Esther 10:2*

- **THEY LIVE PEACEFULLY**

³ For Mordecai the Jew was second only to King Ahasuerus and great among the Jews, and in favor with the multitude of his kinsmen, one who sought the good of his people and one who spoke for the welfare of his whole nation. Esther 10:3
